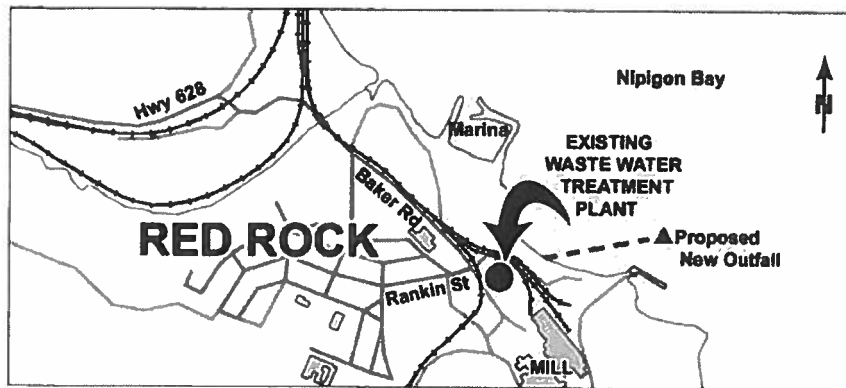

# WASTE WATER TREATMENT PLANT UPGRADE

## Public Comment Invited

The Township of Red Rock is proposing a study to upgrade the waste water treatment facility from primary to secondary treatment. A Class Environmental Assessment (Class EA) was completed in March 2004. However since then, the Township has concluded the following:

- The favoured treatment solution should be the most economical to operate;
- The existing plant equipment is outdated and there may be insufficient land available at the existing site to accommodate the proposed secondary treatment process;
- The existing effluent outfall should be relocated.



Phase I of the study will consider the Township's conclusions and update the preliminary design study and amend the Class EA as required. Subject to the outcome of this review and any public concerns received, the project will proceed under either Schedule B or Schedule C of the Municipal Class Environmental Assessment. The Township will retain the option after completion of the preliminary design report to proceed with Phase II of the study which involves completion of the detail design and tendering of the construction project.
