Heather Brown and Jessica Vail from the Ministry of Municipal Affairs and Housing, in their presentation, explained to Council why financial reporting of municipalities is invaluable to both the province of Ontario and the municipality as this reporting, in the form of a Financial Information Return, is used by the province in calculating grant amounts, developing policy and monitoring the financial status of the municipality. As for the municipality, the Financial Information Return is an important tool for comparing year to year, trend analysis, forecasting and planning. The Ministry also uses Financial Indicators (generated by the Financial Information Return) to review the financial status of the municipality. These indicators also help to facilitate dialogue with Council on financial management practices. Heather went through each indicator as it applied to Red Rock and offered tools that the municipality could use for improvement going forward.
