### Proposed Itinerary- Day 1

- 9:00am – Good morning! Begin driving on highway 11/17 heading east
- 10:30am – Welcome to Red Rock! Stop by Saunders Food and to get some food supplies
- 11:00am – Head to Pull-A-Log Park and take a stroll down the beautiful boardwalk
- 11:30am – Go to the marina docks to meet your charter captain
- 11:45pm – When you're all packed up, head out on vast, breathtaking Lake Superior!
- 12:00pm – Ask your captain to point out some of the landmark sights
- 1:00pm – Anchor at an island to stretch your legs and take a look around
- 1:20pm – Find a shady spot to sit down and enjoy your lunch
- 1:50pm – Hop back aboard your boat and get to the water
- 2:00pm – Cruise around islands and take in the sights, maybe you'll see some wildlife!
- 3:30pm – Head back to the Red Rock marina
- 4:00pm – Arrive back in Red Rock to unload from your travels
- 4:15pm – Check into your room and take a well-deserved rest
- 6:00pm – Head to the Down by the Bay Café located in the Red Rock Marina Building

1:45pm – Feeling adventurous? Call ahead and have Epic Adventures plan an afternoon of activities

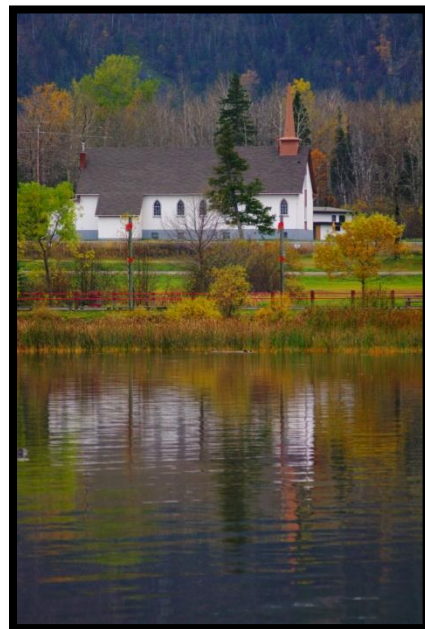
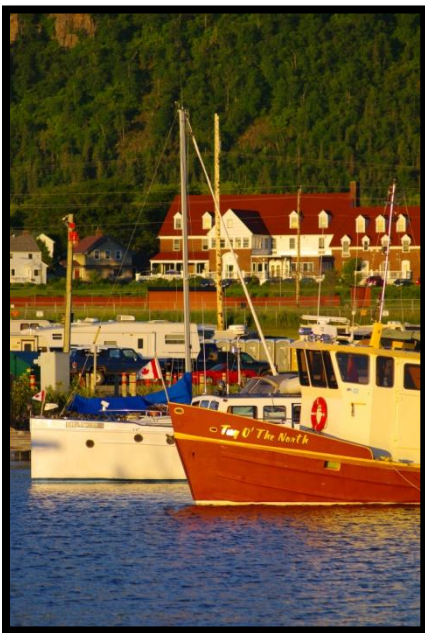
3:45pm – Don't leave without checking out the new Marina building and splash pad at the marina!

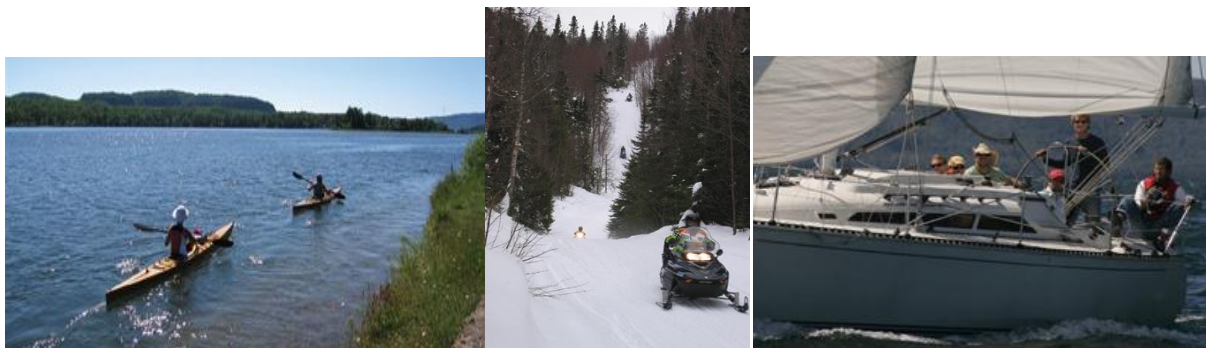
