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REPORTS OF OFFICERS

Chief Administrative Officer

The CAO reviewed her written report with Council.

A recommendation will be brought to the next meeting of Council regarding the Temporary Landfill Site Attendant position.

The Mayor and CAO updated Council of the progress of securing funding for the WWTP from the Federal and Provincial Governments. Mayor Nelson will be attending a social with MPP Gravelle and MP Hajdu on December 19, 2017.

The CAO informed Council on the reduction of OMPF funding dollars as well as MPAC's levy increase.

FedNor has shown interest in partnering with NOHFC and the Township for the RV Study. With this partnership, the Township's contribution has been reduced significantly from \$17,500 to \$5,600.

JML will be in attendance at the January 15, 2018 Council meeting to discuss the Bridge Study of the Four Bridges.

Payments for payroll and operations were submitted for approval.

Public Works Superintendent

The PWS reviewed his report with Council.

The Water Treatment Plant's circulation pump is to be assessed to determine if it needs replacement. Water sampling resulted in no adverse results.

Some troubleshooting at the Rec Centre was performed for the kitchen dishwasher, ice plant's condenser water pump and the condenser itself. All issues have been remedied at this point in time. A Union Gas correction order has also been remedied.

Extra stringer sets for Bridge #3 were needed to complete the repairs on that bridge. Two remaining details for the bridges have to be completed before JML's final inspection.

Animal Control Officer

The Mayor reviewed the Animal Control Officer's report as submitted.

Fire Chief Monthly Report

The Mayor reviewed the Fire Chief's report in his absence.

REPORTS OF COMMITTEES

Red Rock Recreation Advisory Committee Minutes – December 7, 2017

The Mayor reviewed the minutes with Council.

Both Don Evans and Meagan Shwetz were approved to sit on the Recreation Advisory Committee for the remaining term of Council.

Red Rock Public Library Regular Meeting Minutes – December 14, 2017

The Red Rock Public Library Computer Usage/Internet Access Policy was approved.

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Two resolutions from the December 12, 2017 meeting were approved. Brooke Jean was awarded the position of Causal Junior Assistant Librarian and the Chief Librarian was authorized to advertise for the position of a technology student which will be funded by the Improving Digital Services Fund.
