

## ALERTS IN EFFECT

### Winter Storm Warning

Issued at 10:08 Wednesday 23 December 2020

A significant winter storm is expected today.

Snow will continue today and gradually taper to flurries from west to east on Thursday.

Total snowfall amounts of 25 to 35 cm are expected by Thursday afternoon. Total accumulations of up to 50 cm locally are possible.

Snow may mix with rain along the shoreline of Lake Superior this morning and into this afternoon as temperatures briefly rise above the freezing mark. As a result, lesser snowfall accumulations are anticipated immediately along the lake shore.

Brisk northerly winds gusting 50 to 60 km/h are expected from this evening into Thursday and will result in localized blowing snow over exposed areas.

Driving conditions will continue to deteriorate today as the snow continues.

**Note:**

Surfaces such as highways, roads, walkways and parking lots may become difficult to navigate due to accumulating snow. **Red Rock residents** are asked to ensure personal vehicles are not parked on streets over night to assist our Public Work Crew during plowing operations.
