Candidates must be:

18 years of age or older.

Physically fit for the position of firefighter and able to pass a physical.

Able to complete a D.Z. Driving Test within 2 years.

Able to attend Fire Practices the 1st & 3rd Monday of each month between 7:00 - 10:00pm except July & August

If you are a motivated individual with the desire to create positive change in your community, then this may be your calling.
